FINANCIAL

WHAT THE FEES COVER:

The Busisa Adventure Gap Year fees cover cost of tuition, board and lodging during the duration of the course (February to graduation in December). In detail they cover:

- 1X Main meal a day (excluding breaks and holidays)
- Accommodation
- Travel costs to and from all activities, outreaches and events forming part of the Busisa Adventure Gap Year.
- Camps, Activities, Outreaches etc.
- Books, Resources and Busisa kit (clothing and gear).
- Once off contribution towards the running of the administrative office
- 1Gb Wifi per month

WHAT THE FEES DO NOT COVER:

- Medical expenses
- Personal items and toiletries
- Travel to and from Busisa during breaks and holidays
- Personal Phone and Cell phone calls
- Personal insurance on valuables e.g. Cars, cellphones, laptops etc.

There may be additional fundraising done during the duration of the year to cover shortfalls. This fundraising will be done as a team and money raised will contribute to the program.
